If a player is wanting to tryout for a higher age group then they need permission to do so by the NTSC Director of Coaching and Player Development – Garry Norman. There is a non-refunded fee of \$25 to tryout, this fee includes a tryout t-shirt. NTSC will be holding tryouts for all ages (boys & girls) for Challenge level and U12 girls & U16 boys for the classic level. All coaches for these teams will be selected and approved by the Director of Competition and Director of Coaching and Player Development. Tryout Registration for Challenge and U16 boys Classic play will be held from 10:00-1:00 on May 3 at the King Soccer Complex Concession Stand. Tryout Registration for the U12 Girls will be held on April 28 from 6:30-8:00 at the King Public Library. Tryout Registration forms can be mailed in before Tryouts. Registration will be held at the field 30 mins before the Tryout time for each age group. If you can not make a tryout date then please contact Garry Norman for options. ## **U10 Academy Program**

NTSC will be offering a new soccer program “U10 Academy” this fall for the U9 and U10 age group. This program is open for both boys and girls. Interested players will participate in a training session on May 21 & 22 at 6:30-8:00 at Pinnacle Elem School. A parent information session will also take place during the training session to go program goals and expectations and sideline conduct. The Academy program is a unique way to develop soccer players that is backed by US Youth Soccer and North Carolina Youth Soccer. The Academy program emphasis training and development of the player. The Academy program has guidelines on what type of coaches work in the program and also the training curriculum at each club has to follow to state guidelines approved by the Academy committee and State Director of Coaching. Matches are setup over the summer for the fall season and over the winter for the spring season. Each club tries to host other clubs within the program on various weekends during the season. The Travel possibilities will be discuss with the parents before a season is before the schedule is finalized. There are also U10 Academy Festivals in the Fall and Spring season each program can go to. There will also be in house matches within the NTSC Academy Program. There is no score kept by either team, there are only winners in the Academy program. The Academy program is a joint effort by the clubs that have players in the program to develop players in the game of soccer. To promote player development and good sportsmanship. Cheering for good play regardless of who the player plays for is strongly encourage.

### **Academy Coaching Staff**

The NTSC Coaching staff will be determine by the Director of Coaching & Player Development. The NTSC Academy Program Director will be Garry Norman, who holds a USSF National Youth License, NSCAA Premier Diploma and USSF 'B' License and NSCAA Goalkeeper Level I Diploma. Each coach in the program will be a Youth license coach. Each coach will have an opportunity to work with each player in the program either as a trainer or match coach during the season.

### **Team Selection:**

Each player will be grouped into a pool of players, U9 Girls, U9 Boys, U10 Girls or U10 Boys. This would be a player pool for that age. How Teams will be selected for matches will depend on the number of players in each pool and availability to play that weekend. The potential for crossover in each pool is there depending on the number of players available to play a certain weekend. There will be an effort made by the NTSC Academy to pair up our teams equally against other Academy program teams. Teams will carry two names, NTSC Stokes Spirits for Girls and NTSC Strikeforce for boys. Colors will be use to apply to more one team in each pool. Team rosters will change from weekend to weekend. Communication from the staff to the parents will happen during the training session prior to play weekend so each player will know which team he/she is on and what time they play, Also the match coach will be selected for that play weekend. There are no set teams or rosters. There is freedom to play with other academy programs teams also if we have number problems for a contest.

### **Player Evaluations:**

There will be two written player evaluations each season for each player by the Academy staff. This will be a detail assessment where the player is at in his/her soccer development approved by the Academy Director.

### **Academy Fees and Payment Schedule**

The program will cost \$250 for the 2008-2009 season. Installments can be made by the following schedule: June 1 - \$100, July 1 - \$75 August 1- \$75, Cost does not include the uniform, Each player will wear a NTSC Jersey which can be ordered from Soccer Unlimited, Just let them know you with the NTSC academy program. Each player will be assigned a Jersey number. Academy colors are red/white, Red – away jersey, White – home jersey, red socks and red shorts. What jersey is worn at the match will be determined if we are the home or away team on the schedule.

Academy Registration will be held from 10:00-1:00 on May 3 at the King Soccer Complex Concession Stand.
