# Instructor's Bios

Chris Manley (Director) – Chris has been the Head Men's Varsity Soccer Coach of West Stokes High School since it opened. In his past four seasons, he has compiled a 60-25-8 regular-season record. At the high school level, Coach Manley is the former Central Carolina Coach of the Year and the former Region 8 Coach of the Year. As a select coach, he has an overall record of 99-23-8. Chris is also the head coach for North Carolina's South Region High School Showcase Team, which is currently the defending champions. He holds a USSF National "D" Coaching License and has been a skills coach and camp instructor for eight years.

Susie Parsons- Susie was a four-year All conference player at UNCG. She has been an asst. coach there for five years. During that time, they have won the Southern Conference Championship twice and gone to the NCAA tournament twice, advancing to the second round in 2000. She also coaches the Greensboro Twisters. Susie holds the USSF National "C" Coaching License.

Maurice Melvin- Coach Melvin has been a Head Coach in the CCSC and Skills Coach in the GYSA. Maurice owns his own soccer development and consulting business- Footcoach Soccer Training. He holds the NSCAA State Diploma and USSF National "D" License.

Benji Knox- Coach Knox is a former high school and collegiate standout in cross-country and soccer. After All-region Junior and Senior Seasons in high school, Benji went on to play soccer at East Carolina and Anderson University. Coach Knox has led his team to the playoffs consistently as the Head Cross Country Coach at West Stokes H.S. Coach Knox is also a registered nurse at WFUBMC.

Shanna Morton- Shanna was four-year starter for Greensboro College. She was an all-conference standout at South Stokes High School from 1996-1999. Shanna holds the State Youth Coaching License.

Gerry Gibson- Gerry is former college player for Belmont Abbey College. He is also a member of the West Stokes Coaching Staff. Gerry is a soccer coach for the NTSC's U16 United. He also led the West Stokes Junior Varsity team to a 7-3-1 in 2005.

Coach Norman also is the boys and girls Head Coach at Atkins High School. Coach Norman currently coaches the U12 NTSC Stokes Spirits Girls challenge team
